



### The new Pistol News information format

All future correspondence between SAPF and the membership will be done formally via this new Pistol News format.

This simple A4-page format has been chosen because it can be easily pinned onto Club Noticeboards, or printed and handed out to club members where clubs have such facilities.

With time, we will use the same format to give voice to the membership, who can use the Pistol News to have their say, or broadcast their ideas.

### National Postal League in on

I have only received one query regarding the postal League, and since there has been no other questions or queries about the event, we will go ahead for 2017 as outlined in the previous notice sent out during August 2017.

The shooting programme is as follows:

1. Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> October, 2017:  
50-M Free Pistol and 50 Yards Deliberate.
2. Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2017:  
25-M Standard Pistol and Sport Pistol
3. Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> November 2017:  
25\_M Centerfire and Olympic Rapid Fire
4. Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2017:  
10-M Air Pistol.

We need Club Presidents and the responsible R/O's to score and check the targets and complete the Excel spreadsheet in which the scores need to be recorded - the Excel spreadsheet will be emailed to all clubs as well.

Members will compete in their event Gradings, and clubs should check, review and return the scoresheets to the SAPF offices by the 16<sup>th</sup> December 2017.

SAPF will release the results of the National Postal League by 12<sup>th</sup> January, 2018.

Clubs are to keep the Postal League targets safe and secure until 12<sup>th</sup> January, 2018 in case there are queries or tied results, in which case, the SAPF office will contact the club/s in question directly.

Members will be able to upgrade based on their results in the National Postal League, and the National Postal League results will be maintained separately from the National Log, since it is a different project compared to Provincial and National Championships.

One important proviso is that shooters MUST use the official SAPF targets that are available from the SAPF offices.

This is the only cost involved for participants, otherwise this is your chance to compete against every other person in your grade *at no charge*, and may the best shooter win!

We look forward to having a super involvement from the entire membership base, and we ask members to please participate, since there are no costs attached and everyone is competing on their home turf, so they should be at their best in their home environment.
